The above project is located within the boundaries of the Westside Union School District, and the District acknowledges that it will serve the students generated from this tract.

At the present time, students generated from this project will attend our Leona Valley School, 9063 West Leona Avenue, Leona Valley, CA 93551, (661) 948-9010 for grades K-8. Please note that boundaries of schools within our District are subject to change depending upon area growth which could result in students being reassigned to a different school within our District.

The Westside Union School District school facilities are presently inadequate to address District needs as there are currently un-housed students warranting the assessment of Level II Developer Fees. In addition, the District anticipates a significant increase in student enrollment based on the numerous housing projects in the planning process pending approval or recently approved. For this reason the District is of the opinion that the District's school facilities and ability to serve those children within its jurisdiction will be significantly impacted by new project approval in a manner that cannot be fully mitigated by the payment of the current Level II fees alone.
